

9 . HUNGRY HATTAV(ANNADHANA MAHADHANA)

There are more than 10000 people who are taking care of patients who are supposed to be family members of admitted patients in government hospitals at Bangalore. Most of these people are from outside, especially from rural areas and belong to economically weaker sections.



They are taking care of these patients with empty pockets and struggling to fill their empty stomach. However admitted patients will get food from the hospital but people who take care of them are in deep trouble. CHILD SUPPORT FOUNDATION understands this situation and launched a program called HUNGRY HATAV.



Every day (Mon to Sat) our vehicle will go to these hospitals with food packets and distribute them to needy ones. This is not a one day activity this will be the daily program.



9 . HUNGRY HATTAV(ANNADHANA MAHADHANA)-2



Initially we are feeding about 400 peoples in a day. Now through donor support we extend it 450 plus food packets. We would like this program to take it to the next level and target beneficiaries at least 1000 lunches a day.

will distribute food packets at INDIRA GANDHI CHILDREN HOSPITAL later we love to spread to Nimhans, Rajiv Gandhi hospital, Sanjay Gandhi Hospitals Bangalore. This year we successfully reached 1,50,000 beneficiaries because of your support keep continue your generous support to need y people.

13 . ORPHANAGE SUPPORT PROGRAM

An orphanage is a residential institution devoted to the care of orphans, Semi Orphans children whose biological parents are deceased or otherwise unable or unwilling to care for them. Biological parents, and sometimes biological grandparents, are legally responsible for supporting children but in the absence of willing to care for the children, they become a ward of the state, and orphanages are one way of providing for their care, housing and education.
